Councilmember Spradley made a specific motion - " I move that the property tax rate for tax year 2023 be increased by the adoption of a total ad valorem property tax rate of .408936 per \$100 of assessed taxable valuation, which is effectively an 8.6% increase in the tax rate, with .208936 for debt service and .200000 cents for operations and maintenance." Mayor Pro Tem Bowers seconded this motion which passed unanimously.
