A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SCHMIDT AVENUE SIDEWALKS AND SAN ANTONIO STREET SIGNAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FUNDED THROUGH THE ALAMO AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) issued a call for Program projects for the FY 2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels submitted the Schmidt Avenue sidewalks and San Antonio Street (at Academy Ave) traffic signal, for consideration in the program; and

WHEREAS, the two locations were selected for funding through the AAMPO funding program to improve pedestrian mobility and safety in New Braunfels; and

WHEREAS, federal participation will be 100% of the construction costs up to \$141,779 for the sidewalks and \$405,968 for the traffic signal, the City of New Braunfels will be responsible for any overages during construction; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels is also responsible for TxDOT's direct costs, \$6,611, associated with project review, inspection, administration, and oversight; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels is authorized to enter into an agreement with TxDOT and confirms the financial commitment including payment of overruns through the City of New Braunfels' capital project funding programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS:

THAT, the City Manager is authorized to enter into an Advance Funding Agreement between the City of New Braunfels and Texas Department of Transportation, further authorized to execute all necessary documents, and accept funding associated with the Schmidt Avenue sidewalks and San Antonio Street traffic signal.
