**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR – HOMELAND SECURITY GRANTS DIVISION, STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$52,500 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THIS GRANT, INCLUDING EXECUTION OF ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION ASSOCIATED WITH ANY RESULTING AWARD.**

**Whereas**, the City of New Braunfels is eligible to submit an application for funding in the amount of \$52,500 under the Office of the Governor – Homeland Security Grants Division, State Homeland Security Program; and

**Whereas**, the Fire Department has developed the “Hazardous Materials – Product Identification Program” grant application project; and

**Whereas**, a grant award under this program would benefit the citizens of New Braunfels by enhancing the City of New Braunfels Fire Department’s effectiveness and efficiency of programs and activities; and

**Whereas**, there is no matching requirement for this grant and the total grant funded request is \$52,500; and

**Whereas**, the City of New Braunfels agrees to return all funding to the Governor’s Office Homeland Security Grants Division in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds;

**Whereas**, the City of New Braunfels authorizes the City Manager to apply for, accept, alter, or terminate the grant application;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS:**

**THAT**, the City Council hereby authorizes the submission of the application for funding under the Office of the Governor – Homeland Security Grants Division, State Homeland Security Program in the amount of \$52,500 and authorizes the City Manager to act on behalf of the City of New Braunfels in all matters related to this grant, including execution of all required documentation associated with any resulting award.
