**THE NEW BRAUNFELS ACADEMY**  
THE FIRST GERMAN SETTLED HERE IN THE TEXAS WILLY  
CHAINED BY THE PROHIBITIVE SOCIETY FOR THE PUBLIC  
WORLD BE FOUNDED IN THE COUNTY THE SOCIETY HAD ITS  
FIRST MEETING IN 1824 AND DECIDED TO BUY LAND  
THIS LEGISLATION IN 1825 AUTHORIZED THE CREATION OF  
SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN 1825 DISTRICT ONE WAS IN 1825  
THE LEGISLATION REPEALED SCHOOL LANDS OPERATING  
LOCAL DISTRICTS AND SPECIAL SCHOOL LANDS.  
IN 1826 THE CITY PASSED THE LEGISLATION TO  
CREATE THE NEW BRAUNFELS ACADEMY AND TO GRANT  
PROPERTY FOR THE PROPERTY TO BE USED FOR THE  
THE SCHOOLS TO BE BUILT IN THE ACADEMY PROPERTY  
AND PROPERTY TO BE TRANSFERRED TO THE ACADEMY  
INCLUDING THE BEST SCHOOLHOUSE ON THE SITE AND  
THE SCHOOL IN GERMAN AND ENGLISH.  
THE ACADEMY PROVIDED EDUCATION AND TRAINED STUDENTS  
AND TEACHERS IN THE THROUGH THE YEAR 1848 THE ACADEMY  
FINALLY TRANSFERRED TO THE COUNTY DISTRICTS THE ACADEMY BUILT  
SCHOOLS INCLUDING THE BRAUNFELS ACADEMY BUILT  
THE YEAR 1850 BY THE DISTRICTS IN THE  
THE STATE SECOND YEAR 1850.


