100 Year celebration: Nathan Manlove and Mary Irwin made contact with someone named Micheal in Braunfels, Germany. He said that nobody from Braunfels was interested in coming to New Braunfels this They said maybe next year." Danielle Crippen asked if there was a specific calendar date that our sister city partnership was signed. Helgard Suhr-Hollis said the official sister city international agreement was not signed until 2010, but the relationship has existed for 100+ years. Mary Irwin mentioned that Braunfels (DE) is having a anniversarv sister city celebration with another European August 21-25 and has invited representatives community from New Braunfels to join. Mary Irwin detailed the communications from Germany and what that will look like. Helgard Suhr-Hollis mentioned that she might go to Germany and will attend on our behalf.
