

RESOLUTION 2025-R60

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM – REGULAR PROJECTS GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE, OR THEIR DESIGNEE, TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THIS GRANT, INCLUDING EXECUTION OF ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION ASSOCIATED WITH ANY RESULTING AWARD.

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Comal County that the proposed “HAZMAT Chemical Detection Equipment” be operated for the 2024 Program Year; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels agrees to provide applicable matching funds for said project as required by the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Homeland Security Grants Division’s 2024 State Homeland Security Program – Regular Projects grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of New Braunfels assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels designates the Director of Finance, or their designee, as the grantee’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS;

THAT, the City of New Braunfels’ City Council approves submission of the grant application for the “HAZMAT Chemical Detection Equipment” to the Office of the Governor; and

THAT, the City of New Braunfels’ City Council approves designation of the Director of Finance, or their designee, as the grantee’s authorized official for all matters related to the grant, with the power to accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.
