Project Summary - Please provide a brief summary outlining the scope of work to be performed for this project.

The front and side wall of the building are in need of repair. We have had difficulty with rain leaking into the building. We have had the façade cleaned to remove dirt/mold so we could see the state of the brick and mortar. Now it is time to replace the failed sealant and reseal the perimeter of the windows, seal penetrations in the brick, and apply a water repellent. The side wall has large cracks in mortar joints over 3 windows and several large holes in the brick.

Our building is 112 years old and is located in the middle of a key block of downtown retail space. The sheer visibility of the façade of the building makes it an attractive feature of downtown. We want to preserve the brick façade and maintain an attractive building for tourists and local alike. To attract visitors to downtown, it is important for the real estate to be attractive and inviting. The Downtown Implementation Plan noted that historic buildings along retail corridors are considered a strength to be capitalized upon during revitalization efforts. Our 112 year old building fits that category. The City's help with this project will be beneficial to helping us maintain a part of New Braunfel's history.
