### ORDINANCE NO. 2024-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS REZONING APPROXIMATELY 30 ACRES, BEING OUT OF THE A. M. ESNAURIZAR SURVEY, ABSTRACT 20, CURRENTLY ADDRESSED AT 1983 STATE HIGHWAY 46 SOUTH, FROM C-1B AH (GENERAL BUSINESS DISTRICT WITH AIRPORT HAZARD OVERLAY) AND MU-A AH (LOW INTENSITY MIXED USE DISTRICT WITH AIRPORT HAZARD OVERLAY) TO MU-A AH (LOW INTENSITY MIXED USE DISTRICT WITH AIRPORT HAZARD OVERLAY); REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of New Braunfels has complied with all requirements of notice of public hearing as required by the Zoning Ordinance of the City of New Braunfels; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with the spirit and objectives of the MU-A AH (Low Intensity Mixed Use District with Airport Hazard Overlay), the City Council has given due consideration to all components of said district; and

WHEREAS, the rezoning is in compliance with the Future Land Use Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the City Council to provide harmony between existing zoning districts and proposed land uses; and

**WHEREAS**, the requested rezoning is in accordance with Envision New Braunfels, the City's Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the Zoning Map by changing the zoning of approximately 30 acres being out of the A. M. Esnaurizar Survey, Abstract 20, currently addressed at 1983 State Highway 46 South from from C-1B AH (General Business District with Airport Hazard Overlay) and MU-A AH (Low Intensity Mixed Use District with Airport Hazard Overlay); and (Low Intensity Mixed Use District with Airport Hazard Overlay); and

now, therefore;

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS:

#### **SECTION 1**

**THAT** pursuant to Section 1.2-3, Chapter 144 of the New Braunfels Code of Ordinances, the Zoning Map of the City of New Braunfels is revised by rezoning the following tract of land from C-1B AH (General Business District with Airport Hazard Overlay) and MU-A AH (Low Intensity Mixed Use District with Airport Hazard Overlay) to MU-A AH (Low Intensity Mixed Use District with Airport Hazard Overlay):

Approximately 30 acres, being out of the A. M. Esnaurizar Survey, Abstract 20, as depicted on Exhibit "A" and delineated in Exhibit "B", attached.

#### **SECTION 2**

**THAT** all other ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict.

## **SECTION 3**

**THAT** if any provisions of this ordinance shall be held void or unconstitutional, it is hereby provided that all other parts of the same which are not held void or unconstitutional shall remain in full force and effect.

#### **SECTION 4**

**THIS** ordinance will take effect upon the second and final reading in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of New Braunfels.


