4	Multiple	City of New Braunfels	Citywide Pedestrian 2028 – filling sidewalk gaps and installing ADA compliant crossings at N Peach Ave, N Plum Ave, N Grape Ave from Michigan St to W San Antonio St, at Avery Parkway from Whispering Way to Avery Ranch Dr, and at Hanz Dr from River Terrace to Gruene Rd.
5	Multiple	City of New Braunfels	Signal Timing Optimization – retime traffic signals to improve traffic flow through the City’s signalized intersections.
