A RESOLUTION AND A RATIFICATION OF THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING OFFERED BY THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TEXAS TRAFFIC SAFETY PROGRAM'S SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM – COMPREHENSIVE FY 2023 GRANT, AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT FUNDS AND TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE GRANT, IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels has submitted an application in the amount of \$52,368.79 for funding offered by the Texas Traffic Safety Program's Selective Traffic Enforcement Program – Comprehensive (STEP-COMP) FY 2023 grant, issued by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and administered by the Texas Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS the City of New Braunfels herein verifies that it has an available cash reserve not less than 100% of the proposed grant amount of \$52,368.79 which the amount will be reserved until the end of the contract; and

WHEREAS the City of New Braunfels herein verifies that it has an available amount of \$11,142.79 which presents the minimum 20% grant match requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS;

THAT, the City of New Braunfels will accept funding as offered by the Texas Department of Transportation, Texas Traffic Safety Program's Selective Traffic Enforcement Program – Comprehensive (STEP-COMP) FY 2023 grant in the amount of \$52,368.79 and authorizes the City Manager or authorized designee to act on behalf of the City in matters as required by the grant.
