

RESOLUTION 2026 – RXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS APPROVING A RECOMMENDATION OF THE NEW BRAUNFELS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR A PROJECT EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$700,000 TO THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AAMPO CITYWIDE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 1, PURSUANT TO SECTION 505.152 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the New Braunfels Economic Development Corporation (NBEDC) met on February 19, 2026 and approved four strategic priority categories – workforce support, planning and infrastructure, placemaking/quality of life, and business recruitment and retention – to guide future project expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) Citywide Pedestrian Phase 1 Improvement Project is identified as a planning an infrastructure project; and

WHEREAS, the NBEDC met on April 16, 2026, to consider a request from the City of New Braunfels to fund the construction match of AAMPO Citywide Pedestrian Improvements Phase 1; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will increase pedestrian connectivity by completing sidewalk gaps and addressing ADA concerns at Alves Lane & Brook Avenue, Christus Santa Rosa area, Hinman Island Drive, County Line Road & FM725, and Oak Run Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the NBEDC previously funded the final design for this project on April 20, 2023; and

WHEREAS, AAMPO plans to cover 80% of the construction costs and 20% remains for the construction match funding requirement; and

WHEREAS, this project expenditure is authorized under 505.152 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the NBEDC held a public hearing on May 21, 2026, to request public comments about this project expenditure; and

WHEREAS, after discussing the item, the NBEDC voted to approve the expenditure in an amount up to \$700,000 to fund the construction match of AAMPO Citywide Pedestrian Improvements Phase 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS:

SECTION 1: That the recommendation of the NBEDC to approve a project expenditure of \$700,000 to the City of New Braunfels for the construction match of AAMPO Citywide Pedestrian Improvements Phase 1 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: That a contract between the NBEDC and the City of New Braunfels will be

executed to fulfill the terms and conditions of the project expenditure and the NBEDC President and Secretary are authorized to execute the document.

SECTION 3: That this resolution shall become effective from and after the date of its passage.
