A) System-Wide Master Plan Update

Jeff Bransford, Park Development Manager, provided an update on the System-Wide Master Plan. The current stage of the plan is the Prioritization of Capital Projects. Three Strategic Priorities will be selected to guide the prioritization of the projects. The strategies could include 1. Protect health and safety 2. Scale responsibly and sustainability, and 2. Preserve existing assets.

Next steps: This presentation will go to City Council on Jan 20, Master Plan Consultants and Parks staff will hold a Capital Projects Prioritization workshop on Jan 23, and on Feb 10 the recommended capital priorities/projects will be presented to Park Board.

B) Capital Projects Update

Scott McClelland, Assistant Transportation and Construction Services Director provided an update on:

Dry Comal Creek Segment 1 - proposed bidding in 2027

Segments 2&3 - Feasibility study is complete, finishing ROW acquisitions and securing funding for design and construction.

Alligator Creek Trail West - complete!

Alligator Creek Trail East - Working through final design of Phase 1 through Spring of 2027, construction to begin later in 2027

Waterway Lane Trail Phase 1 - Gruene Rd to Old 306. Construction funding from MPO.

Landa Dam - Projectd funded by EDC, expected to finish in January. Spillway improvements still coming

Mission Hill Park - expected completion in April.

Zipp Family Sports Park-Close to completion, operations to be taken over by Parks staff for grass grow in, construction close out in progress.
