a. Headstone Cleaning

Chad was able to give the group a good look into the site. There is still a lot of work to be done and Chronicle is working on entering all the data.

d. Field of Graves

Chad presented a PowerPoint going over the history of how this project started and how we got to where we are today. THC found several historical and prehistoric findings during construction. Those findings will require work to stop within 50ft of set locations. City staff met with the original design team to discuss options for redesign and new cost considerations, recommending completing additional archeological survey to determine space available for redesign.

e. 2024 Soul Searching Event

The group is continuing to discuss possible actors to portray the souls and deciding the best route to take through the cemetery. Jan will be reaching out to HEB for the 500 water donation. Chad received a quote of \$2200 for electric golf cart rental and delivery. This would be for 6 6-seater carts. The suggestion was made to look at Golf Cart specific sponsorships. Each cart would be a \$366.67/sponsorship. The group would like to open the idea of raising the price on tickets to \$25/tickets.
