ORDINANCE NO. 2025-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 126-346 AND SECTION 86-7 TO RESTRICT PARKING IN CYPRESS BEND PARK

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that installation of traffic control devices is necessary in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS:

THAT the City of New Braunfels Code of Ordinances Section 126-346 (f) is hereby amended as follows:

Ι.

- (33) On the west side of Jesse Guerrero Circle from the intersection with Peace Avenue northerly for a distance of 425 feet. Such no parking zone shall be designated as a tow-away zone.
- (34) On both sides of Jesse Guerrero Circle from a point 425 feet from the intersection with Peace Avenue northerly to and including the entirety of the Jesse Guerrero Circle loop, excluding the public water vessel loading zone established by ordinance. Such no parking zone shall be designated as a tow-away zone.
- (139) On the east side of Jesse Guerrero Circle from the intersection with Peace Avenue northerly for a distance of 165 feet. Such no parking zone shall be designated as a tow-away zone.

II.

THAT the City of New Braunfels Code of Ordinances Section 86-7 is hereby amended as follows:

(c) Cypress Bend Park. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle within Cypress Bend Park other than in designated marked parking spaces or in the designated marked on-street parking spaces on the east

III.

THAT all provisions hereof are hereby declared to be severable and if any provisions hereof is declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, such shall not invalidate or affect the remaining provisions hereof which will be and remain in full force and effect.

IV.

THAT it is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance should be declared invalid by the final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance.

V.

This Ordinance shall become adopted and effective upon its second reading, signature required by City Charter, and filing with the City Secretary's Office. This Ordinance must also be published in a newspaper of general circulation at least one time within ten (10) days after its final passage, as required by the City Charter of the City of New Braunfels.
