

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-\_\_\_\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 126-136 OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS CODE OF ORDINANCES TO AMEND THE SCHOOL ZONES FOR LONE STAR EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER.**

WHEREAS, after engineering and field investigation, the City Engineer has recommended that traffic control signs be installed on certain streets, avenues, thoroughfares and boulevards within the corporate limits of the City of New Braunfels in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS:

**I.**

THAT the City of New Braunfels Code of Ordinances Section 126-136 (a) is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) No person shall drive any vehicle on the following streets within the areas designated in this subsection during the posted hours or when the school zone flashing lights are operating from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on each scheduled school day during every authorized school term, in excess of 20 miles per hour; and 30 miles per hour at every other time:
- (1) Guenther Avenue between Business 35 and Butcher Street.
  - (2) Butcher Street between Magazine Avenue and Santa Clara Avenue.
  - (3) Magazine Avenue between Butcher Street and Business 35.
  - (4) Nacogdoches Street between 200 feet east of Magazine Avenue and Santa Clara Avenue.
  - (5) Church Hill Drive between 116 feet southwest of the Loop 337 Frontage Road and the intersection with Broadway.
  - (6) Loop 337 Frontage Road between Loop 337 and Church Hill Drive.
  - (7) Oak Run Point between State Highway 46 to dead end.
  - (8) Ohio Avenue between 200 feet east of Brentwood Drive and its end southwest of Kentucky Boulevard.

- (9) Guenther Avenue between Butcher Street and 200 feet northwest of W. Coll Street.
- (10) Clemens Avenue between W. Coll Street and 200 feet northwest of W. Coll Street.
- (11) Magazine Avenue between Butcher Street and 200 feet northwest of W. Coll Street.
- (12) W. Coll Street between 200 feet northeast of Magazine Avenue and 200 feet south of S. Guenther Avenue.
- (13) Howard Street between Fredericksburg Road and 190 feet east of N. Walnut Avenue.
- (14) Fredericksburg Road between 150 feet north of Wood Road and 50 feet south of Oakcrest Drive.
- (15) Bell Street between 180 feet west of Rosemary Drive and Fredericksburg Road.
- (16) Rosemary Drive between Howard Street and Starcrest Drive.
- (17) Parkview Drive between Oakcrest Drive and Bell Street.
- (18) Avery Parkway between 570 feet south of Whispering Way and 535 feet north of Conner Drive.
- (19) Goodwin Lane between 528 feet north of Orion Drive and 530 feet north of Dove Hollow Drive.
- (20) Escarpment Oak from the intersection at Goodwin Lane southeasterly for a distance of 880 feet.
- (21) Settlers Crossing between S. Walnut Avenue and Savannah Hill Circle.
- (22) Klein Way between Klein Road and Settler's Crossing.
- (23) Hidalgo Avenue from the intersection with Spur Street to the intersection with Mill Street.
- (24) N. Lone Star Avenue from the intersection with W. San Antonio Street northerly for a distance of 280 feet.
- (25) S. Lone Star Avenue from the intersection with W. San Antonio Street to a point 490 feet south of the intersection with Zamora Avenue.

- (26) W. San Antonio Street from the intersection with N. Grape Avenue to a point 150 feet west of the intersection with S Lone Star Avenue.
- (27) Zamora Avenue from the intersection with Lone Star Avenue to the intersection with Hidalgo Avenue.
- (28) School Avenue from the intersection with Zamora Avenue southerly for a distance of 375 feet.
- (29) Main Street between Houston Avenue and Veramendi Avenue.
- (30) Commerce Street between Houston Avenue and Veramendi Avenue.
- (31) Veramendi Avenue between Common Street and Camp Street.
- (32) Houston Avenue between Common Street and Camp Street.
- (33) Central Avenue between Common Street and Main Street and between Commerce Street and Camp Street.
- (34) W. Bridge Street between N. Seguin Avenue and Academy Avenue.
- (35) Castell Avenue between W. Mill Street and W. Bridge Street.
- (36) W. Zink Street between Landa Street and dead end.
- (37) Cross Street between Guenther Avenue and Santa Clara Avenue.
- (38) Santa Clara Avenue between Cross Street and W. San Antonio Street.
- (39) Hanz Drive from the intersection of East Common Street westerly for a distance of 610 feet.
- (40) Pahmeyer Road from 200 feet north of the intersection with Rising Sun Boulevard to a point 540 feet southeast of the intersection with Cooper Lane.
- (41) Rising Sun Boulevard from the intersection with Pahmeyer Road to a point 260 feet west of the intersection with Sunset View.
- (42) Oak Run Parkway from 100 feet west of the intersection with Oak Brook Drive east to the city limits.
- (43) Kerlick Lane from the intersection of Mission Hills Drive to 515 feet to the northeast.

- (44) Mission Hills Drive from the intersection of Kerlick Lane to 585 feet to the southeast.
- (45) Ridge Hill Drive from the intersection with Mission Hills Drive to 545 feet to the southwest.
- (46) Timber Drive from the intersection with Kerlick Lane to 100 feet to the southeast.
- (47) West Klein Road from 325 feet southwest of the intersection with Klein Way to a point 300 feet northeast of the intersection with Klein Way.
- (48) Avery Parkway between 570 feet south of Whispering Way and 200 feet north of Avery Ranch Drive.

## II.

THAT the Public Works Department is directed oversee the installation of the traffic control signs in the locations as set forth in this ordinance, and is directed to maintain the signs in a manner that provides for the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of New Braunfels.

## III.

THAT all provisions hereof are hereby declared to be severable and if any provisions hereof is declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, such shall not invalidate or affect the remaining provisions hereof which will be and remain in full force and effect.

## IV.

This Ordinance shall become adopted and effective upon its second reading, signature required by City Charter, and filing with the City Secretary's Office. This Ordinance must also be published in a newspaper of general circulation at least one time within ten (10) days after its final passage, as required by the City Charter of the City of New Braunfels.
