

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT (AFA) WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR 0915-00-320 NEW BRAUNFELS BIKE/PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS (Citywide) PROJECT FUNDED THROUGH THE ALAMO AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE (TASA) PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on 21 August 2025, via Minute Order 116997, the Texas Transportation Commission authorized VA:0915-00-320; New Braunfels Bike/Ped project (the “Project”) to receive Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TASA) funds for project construction, and Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) oversight; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels submitted the Citywide Pedestrian Improvements Project including pavement rehabilitation, increased pedestrian mobility, and traffic mitigation at multiple locations throughout the city (Avery Parkway, Hanz Drive, Peach Avenue, Plum Avenue, and Grape Avenue); and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels commits to provide 20% of the construction cost, with the remaining 80% being provided federally through Texas Department of Transportation and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels is also responsible for TxDOT’s direct costs, \$74,313, associated with project review, inspection, administration, and oversight; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels is responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of New Braunfels desires to reaffirm its support of the Project, approve and authorize the execution of an Advance Funding Agreement (AFA) with TxDOT for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS

THAT The City Manager is authorized to enter into an Advance Funding Agreement between the City of New Braunfels and the Texas Department of Transportation, and is further authorized to execute all necessary documents and accept funding associated with the 0915-00-320 New Braunfels Citywide Bike and Pedestrian Improvements.
