### 3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

March 10, 2022 minutes

Mr. Dietert made a motion to accept minutes as written. Mr. Yoder seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion passed.

#### 4. CITIZENS COMMUNICATIONS

Pam Timmermann asked staff and board why she does not see any construction going on at Barbarosa Rd. near FM 1101. She said that she heard City made plans on widening that road but not seeing anything happening. She said some of her neighbors have been approached on buying their homes and some already sold. Garry then explained that this will be done in stages. Possible in the late summer, FM 1101 to Alves Lane will be the first stage. Then later in 2023 or so Alves to Sanger Halle Rd will the second and so on.

# 5. PRESENTATION

A) Presentation and discussion on the results of the Common Street Traffic and Safety Analysis.: Carly and Garry explained the presentation on Common St. Traffic and Safety Analysis from 337 to Greune Rd. Garry said that DKS recommended a split phasing at the 337 intersection on Common St. Several other plans are going to be done so to move the traffic on Common Street to make it safe and flow traffic better.

A) Discuss and consider a recommendation to City Council to restrict parking on Divine Way at the intersection with S. Walnut Ave. *Carly Farmer, Graduate Engineer* 

Carly explained this item and that citizens have been complaining that parking problems at Divine Way Intersection with Walnut St. She said staff studied this area and felt to recommend a no parking zone on both sides of Divine Way from the intersection with S. Walnut Ave., approximately 75 feet in Northeast direction. Mr. Yoder made a motion to go with the staff recommendations, Mr. Santoni seconded the motion all in favor. Passed.

Gary Kirkham explained that he really enjoyed being on the Bond Advisory Committee. He said it was a real eye opener and saw all the concerns of the needed projects that's need to be on the 2023 Bond. Mike Dietert asked about the repairs that are needed on San Antonio Street from Walnut to Adademy St. Garry Ford explained these problems with this (street) and Klein Rd, and (they) will be addressed soon.
