2017 By the numbers....

- ₹ 2,366 picnic permits issued
- 2,562 total number of rentals
- ≥ 89,033 Number of paid admissions to Landa Park Aquatic Complex
- *697 Fischer Park pavilion rentals
- *15,947 guests at all Fischer Park rentals

Park Maintenance Needs

FY2018 Budget Requests/Unmet Needs

Playground resurfacing (\$80,000)

Hinman Island restroom (\$200,000)

Repave Aquatics parking lot (\$100,000)

Replacement gators (\$22,000)

Equipment (\$102,000)

Hinman Island Playground (\$80,000)

Hinman Island retaining wall (tbd)









Park Rental Fees

- Current non-resident rate is 30% higher than resident rate
 - 49% of all park rentals are non-residents
 - 58% of all Landa Park rentals are non-residents
- Staff proposed adjusted non-resident rate to <u>2X higher</u> than resident rate to Park Advisory Board
 - Estimated to generate \$20,000 in General Fund revenue
- Park Advisory Board recommended adjusting non-resident rate to +130% higher than resident rate
- New revenue will be earmarked for improvements

Fischer Park Rental Fees

- Adjust Pavilions A G (small pavilions) resident rate from \$50 to \$75 for all day use
- More in line with Landa Park pavilion fees
- Change non-resident rate 2X higher (\$150.00), or +130% higher
- Estimated to generate \$20,000 in General Fund revenue
- 45% of Fischer Park rentals are non-residents
- Pavilions rented at 99% capacity April-October 2017



Landa Haus Needs

Needed Repairs/Replacements

- Replace carpet/flooring
- Repair failing retaining wall/deck
- Repaint interior
- Replace window blinds, cabinets
- Replace tables/chairs









Landa Haus Rental Fees

Adjust rates for Landa Haus

- Non-residents rented this facility 66% of the time in FY2017
- Landa Haus fees have not increased since prior to 2001
- Estimated to generate \$100,000 in General Fund revenue
- New revenue will be earmarked for improvements

Picnic Area Needs

Needed Repairs/Replacements

- Replace picnic tables
- Replace trash cans and grills
- Add concrete pads under tables
- Plant additional trees for shade, replace lost trees







Picnic Permit Fees

Adjust from \$10 to \$25 per table

- Non-residents require paid permit for table use
- Residents get first table at no charge
- 85% of permits issued were to nonresidents in FY2017
- Fee has not increased since prior to 2004
- Estimated to generate \$20,000 in General Fund revenue

- Olympic Pool Repainting (\$130,000)
- Funbrella Replacement (\$6,000)
- Bleacher Replacement (\$4,400)
- Replacement Pump (\$4,500)
- Picnic Tables (\$13,500)
- Repaint Bath house (\$22,000)
- Lifeguard Stands (\$6,100)
- Slide Mat & Cargo Net Replacement (\$10,000)
- Kiddie City Slide Repair (tbd)

89,000 paid admissions in FY17

 Does not include swim team visits, swim meet guests or swim lesson customers

- 58,000 total weekend guests
- 80% weekend guests are non-residents
- Anticipated to generate +150,000 in General Fund revenue

Overview

- Use of park rental areas and the Landa Park Aquatic Complex is extremely high during the summer season
- High visitation causes wear and tear on facilities
- Increase revenue from park fees can help to pay for needed repairs and replacements at the facilities
- Fees proposed to be effective March, 2018
 - Would not realize full revenue until FY19 due to already existing reservations for 2018
