**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS,  
APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION 2019  
SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL-INFRASTRUCTURE CALL FOR PROJECTS.**

**Whereas**, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) issued a call for projects in February 2019 for communities to apply for funding assistance through the Safe Routes to School-Infrastructure (SRTS) Program; and

**Whereas**, the SRTS funds may be used for development of plans, specifications, and estimates; environmental documentation; and construction of pedestrian and/or bicycle infrastructure. The SRTS funds do not require a local match. As the Project Sponsor, the Local Government would be responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any, for SRTS funds; and

**Whereas**, the City of New Braunfels will submit for construction cost reimbursement of pedestrian infrastructure adjacent to and near Carl Schurz Elementary School and Lamar Elementary School.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS:**

**THAT**, The City of New Braunfels, Texas, supports funding the Carl Schurz Elementary School and Lamar Elementary School projects, as described in the Local Government's 2019 TASA/SRTS Detailed Application and is willing to commit to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management, and financing. The City of New Braunfels is willing and able to authorize, by resolution or ordinance, the Local Government to enter into an agreement with TxDOT should the project be selected for funding.
