Course Maintenance Update report prepared by Brody Dillard and presented by Chad Donegan.

- All required quarterly maintenance completed and next quarter projects identified.
  Completed projects included overseeding, needle tine, drainage, pre-and post-emerge, cart path, nets in hitting cages and bunker repair. Bunker repair will continue through next quarter.
- Chad and Brody have outlined a long-term strategic plan (through 2039) for improvements and maintenance. At the request of the Advisory Board, further details will be provided at April 2021 meeting.

Tournament/Instruction Update report prepared by Quint Alexander and presented by Chad Donegan.

- Overall tournament play increased 20% to 1,399 total players across 25 events in the first quarter.
- League play data show four of the 12 leagues have increased participation from 9% to 70%, with the greatest increases in Legends and NBGA.
- Spring and Summer golf activities have been submitted to City.

## Q1 Golf Course Financial Update

- Reflecting national trends, LPGC continues to experience higher usage during COVID, even considering the brief shut down in April 2020. First quarter 2020-2021 revenue is \$628,893.08 (26% increase) over first quarter 2019-2020.
- New fleet of golf carts and mower were purchased out of 2020-2021 operating budget versus using reserve funds.
- Current Reserve fund exceeds \$900,000.
