The matrix was provided using the Commissioners scores giving the Commissioners a starting point of reference to begin a dialogue about allocating monies to the Arts applicants for the 2022 HOT funds grants.

Brad Wehring made a motion to reduce Christian Youth Center from \$33,572. to \$24,315. based on two shows performed in Seguin. Tiffany Quiring seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Dee Buck moved to distribute \$3,745.00 which would have been the Brauntex and the New Braunfels Art Council's portion of the \$9,257.00 back to the remaining eight applicants. Tiffany Quiring seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
