5. TREASURER'S REPORT

A) Presentation and discussion on the March 2024 Treasurer's Report Vice President Carden introduced this item.

Jared Werner, Assistant City Manager, presented on this matter. Mr. Werner identified a 4% increase in sales tax collections for January 2024. This increase is a corrected audit adjustment from the December

2023 erroneous sales tax payment. Through the first four months of the fiscal year, collections are still tracking slightly above projections. Additional graphs were provided showing projected revenues, current commitment projections, the projected capacity for additional expenditures, and the proposed ending fund balance to FY25.

6. <u>ADVISORY REPORT</u>

A) Presentation and discussion on its Annual Economic Benchmarks
Report

Vice President Carden introduced this item.

Michele Boggs, Senior VP, New Braunfels Chamber of Commerce, presented this item and addressed the Chamber's 2023 Economic Benchmarks. She addressed data, metrics, and demographic details in categories: population, educational attainment, median household income, employment/unemployment, commuting, primary jobs, property valuation, building permits, property tax, commercial/industrial tax value, sales tax. real estate. business startups, and construction rates.

7. DISCUSSION AND ACTION

A) Discussion and possible action approving the execution of the consent of the New Braunfels Economic Development Corporation as a lienholder to a conveyance of .5 acre of land by Veramendi PE-Darwin, LLC. to directors of Veramendi Master District without waiver or release of lien, and authorizing the NBEDC President to execute the Consent to Conveyance agreement.

Vice President Carden introduced this item.

Jeff Jewell. **Economic** and Community Development Director. presented this item. Mr. Jewell reminded the Board of their 2017 approval of a \$1.6M loan for the Veramendi development project. This loan was secured by a first lien on 43 acres of property within the development. As the first lien holder, the NBEDC must consent to any conveyance of any property within these 43 acreage. At this time, the Water Improvement District is looking to convey a .5 acre lot and the NBEDC must consent to this transaction. Mr. Jewell answered questions from the Board.

Director Austin motioned to approve the item, Director Hammonds seconded the motion, and it was approved unanimously.

B) Presentation and discussion on a proposed project expenditure for the construction of improvements to the Last Tuber's Exit

Vice President Carden introduced this item.

McClelland. Assistant of **Transportation** Scott Director and Capital presented **PowerPoint** addressing item. а this McClelland outlined the plan to replace the exiting stairs and improve safety and access at the Last Tuber's Exit located at the Comal River and the cross streets of E. Lincoln and Union Ave. Objectives of the project are to improve egress from the Comal River, provide an ADA compliant accessible route, and to remove aging NBU water lines and replace the water service at last Tuber's Exit. The NBEDC previously fundina design of the The approved for final project. estimated construction costs for these repairs is \$1,200,000. Mr. McClelland reviewed estimated project schedule and Mr. the next steps. McClelland answered questions from the Board.

- C) Presentation and discussion on a proposed project expenditure for the construction of improvements to the Landa Lake Dam
- McClelland. **Assistant** Director of **Transportation** and Capital **Improvements** presented **PowerPoint** addressing this item. The а Landa Lake Dam is located in Landa Lake and the objectives of this project are to improve the stability of the dam to comply with TCEQ minimize erosion and maintenance requirements, spillway channel, and to replace the sluice gates to control water entering the pool from the lake. The NBEDC previously approved the final design funding for this project. The estimated construction cost is \$1.000.000. McClelland addressed the estimated project schedule Mr. and next steps.


Overview

The Monthly treasurer's report provides updates on sales tax performance, projected revenue streams and projected commitments and timing of expenditures. The financial commitments of the NBEDC typically span multiple fiscal years; therefore, the report is formatted to project the financial position of the NBEDC over the next five years.

Sales Tax

Sales tax collections for the month of February increased by 7.4%. When adjustments are removed, current to current collections increased by 7.9%. At the time this report was completed, the industry level data was not yet available for the month of February. Through the first five months of the fiscal year, sales taxes are down 1.0%, but remain slightly above the FY 2024 budget projection.

Gross Sales Tax Collections



Projected Revenues - FY 2023 to FY 2028





Sales Taxes - the graph and table above reflect the projected sales tax collections through FY 2028. The projections assume conservative growth of 2.5% through FY 2024 and 3% thereafter.

Loan Repayments – The NBEDC began receiving loan repayments from the New Braunfels Regional Airport in FY 2022 (ten year) and ASA properties in FY 2023 (five years with a balloon payment in year six – recognized in FY 2028 above).



Public hearing, discussion, and possible action approving an expenditure of up to \$1,000,000 to the City of New Braunfels for the construction of the Landa Lake Dam & Spillway Improvements, a project authorized under 505.152 of the Texas Local Government Code.

DEPARTMENT: Transportation and Capital Improvements

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The New Braunfels Economic Development Corporation (NBEDC) has worked to develop a list of capital projects to support - through engineering and design and/or construction funding - since the summer of 2022. The NBEDC voted unanimously to approve funding the final design of the Landa Lake Dam project at its March 9, 2023 meeting with Freese and Nichols, Inc (FNI). The final design completed by FNI includes the construction design drawings and an opinion of probable cost for construction.

The repair of the dam will improve global stability of the structure to meet the TCEQ dam safety regulations. The construction of the improvements would add a concrete toe to the existing dam as well as address erosion in the overflow channel to improve stability and maintenance of the channel.

The NBEDC received a presentation on the construction of these improvements at its March 21, 2024 regular meeting. The cost to complete construction of the proposed improvements and for other construction phase expenses is \$1,000,000. If approved by the NBEDC and the City Council, construction would begin after the 2024 Spring Fed Pool season ends.

ISSUE:

The Landa Lake Dam does not meet the TCEQ dam safety regulations. The proposed improvements would improve the dam's stability to meet these regulations.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The construction phase cost is estimated to be \$1,000,000; the NBEDC has adequate funds for this project expenditure.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The New Braunfels Economic Development Corporation (NBEDC) has worked to develop a list of capital projects to support - through engineering and design and/or construction funding - since the summer of 2022. The NBEDC voted unanimously to approve funding the final design of the Last Tuber's Exit project at its January 19, 2023 meeting with Frees and Nichols, Inc (FNI). The final design completed by FNI includes the construction design drawings and an opinion of probable cost for construction.

The proposed improvements to Last Tuber's Exit will help reduce staff intervention, reduce the backup of tubers at the lower landing area and stairs, and improve the safety for staff and park users. The construction of these improvements would replace the underwater stairs with additional steps and a 12' wide underwater landing. Handrails will be replaced, an ADA transfer system will be included, and marker buoys will be added to delineate the underwater landing.

The NBEDC received a presentation on the construction of these improvements at its March 21, 2024 regular meeting. The cost to complete construction of the proposed improvements and for other construction phase expenses is \$1,200,000. If approved by the NBEDC, and the City Council, construction would begin after the 2024 river season ends.

ISSUE:

Last Tuber's Exit requires safety updates to help reduce staff intervention and the backup of tubers exiting the river. These improvements would replace underwater stairs and add additional steps and a wide underwater landing.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The construction phase cost is estimated to be \$1,200,000; the NBEDC has adequate funds for this project expenditure.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approval of \$1,200,000 for the construction of the Last Tuber's Exit Improvements.

On December 15, 2022, the New Braunfels Economic Development Corporation (NBEDC) directed the Transportation and Capital Improvements Department to move forward with the next step for the design of sidewalks as identified in Phase 1 of the Citywide Pedestrian Improvement project. The six sidewalk locations have been broken into two scopes (packages) to address varying complexities. The NBEDC approved funding for final design at its April 20, 2023 meeting and the City Council approved this funding at its May 22, 2023 meeting.

Package 2 of this project includes sidewalks and crossings at: Klein Road Elementary and New Braunfels Middle School area (Settlers Crossing, Pahmeyer Road and Savannah Hill Circle), Landa Street and Loop 337 Access Road intersection, and Oak Run Parkway and Westpointe Drive intersection.




