**ISSUE:**

Continue an ongoing program of infrastructure, construction, and maintenance.  
Seek alternative funding sources to extend city tax dollars.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Funding from the Texas Water Development Board Flood Infrastructure Grant will fund \$706,892.25 of the Drainage Area Master Plan study. \$110,000 of City match funds are allocated in the FY22 Adopted Budget as an Interfund Transfer in the General Fund. The City match funds will be transferred to the Grant Fund to account for all spending and reporting for the grant. The remaining \$399,055 will need to be identified over the next two years as part of the budgeted allocation in the General Fund.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of a Professional Agreement with Freese & Nichols, Inc. for professional services to develop the Drainage Area Master Plan and authorization for the City Manager to execute contract modifications in accordance with the purchasing policy and the appropriate budget amendment.
