



This request was presented to the Transportation and Traffic Advisory Board at their meeting on November 19, 2020. The board voted 4-2 to not amend the existing ordinance to include off-highway vehicles, citing speed, safety, and the inability to police the new types of vehicles as their justification for this recommendation. Two members in opposition expressed support for adding utility vehicles and recreational off-highway vehicles and prohibiting all-terrain vehicles.
