Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of New Braunfels and the Comal County Integrated Response Committee regarding inter-agency cooperation and response to active threats.

BACKGROUND / RATIONALE:

This Memorandum of Understanding is the result of a several years-long collaborative effort involving our local school districts and the many emergency response agencies located in Comal County (New Braunfels Police Department, New Braunfels Fire Department, Comal County Sheriff, Comal County Constable Precinct 3, Garden Ridge Police Department, Bracken Fire Department, Bulverde-Spring Branch Fire/EMS, Canyon Lake Fire/EMS, Schertz EMS, Comal ISD, and New Braunfels ISD).
