#### **BACKGROUND / RATIONALE:**

The City, the New Braunfels Economic Development Corporation (NBEDC), and Comal County desire to expand the use of the County owned property at the corner of E Bridge Street and N Seguin Ave. Once completed the project will accommodate 97 parking spots.

The contract with D&M Owens for \$92,000 includes all associated parking lot construction work and electrical work for added lighting.
