Presentation on activities for Bike Month celebrated during the month of May.

BACKGROUND / RATIONALE:

May is National Bike Month and there will be bike activities within the region and the City of New Braunfels throughout the month. Forty percent of all trips in the U.S. are less than two miles, making bicycling a feasible and fun way to get to work.
